

## Wasatch Academy Scholarship - 2019

The Department of Education, CTA is happy to announce that the Wasatch Academy, Utah, US is offering scholarship for a Tibetan refugee student to pursue High School Education (grade 9 to 12) in their academy. The scholarship will cover tuition fee, room and board, whereas travel expenses has to be borne by oneself. Those interested candidates who meet the following eligibility criteria must apply online using the link below latest by March 31, 2019:

## Eligibility and required documents to be uploaded:

- 1. Applicant and applicant's parents must have paid Green Book (GB) contribution till 2018. Upload first and last page of GB. Those whose parents are in Tibet/separated/deceased, a letter of recommendation to this effect must be produced from the Tibetan Settlement Officer.
- 2. Applicant must be from one of the Tibetan schools under CTA and must have completed Class VIII in 2018 with a score of 75% and above. Upload Class VIII marks card.

## **Selection process:**

1. After the application deadline, there will be a written test of Tibetan, English and Mathemtics in April 2019. The test will be conducted in respective Tibetan Settlement offices. Final score will be distributed as follows with more weightage to Mathematics:

Tibetan = 25%, English = 25% and Mathematics = 50%

- 2. The top four candidates are required to fill Wasatch Academy online application form and submit recommendation letters to the Wasatch Academy. This will be followed by an online interview by a member of Wasatch Academy for final selection in May 2019.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the candidates to produce valid IC by August 2019.
