Eight (8) seats are offered to Tibetan students with a minimum of 60% in Class XII, and who get admission in Tibetan Medical College recognized by the Central Council of Tibetan Medicine.

12. SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP – Master in Museology – 2 (Application Deadline: 30 June, 2018)
Eligibility: BA, B.Sc. BFA with 50% marks
Desirable: A background / PG Diploma in subjects related to History of Arts & Museum Studies
Scholarship: Rs. 200,000/- for entire course
Commitment: After successful completion of course the candidate has to serve in The Tibet Museum, DIIR for at least 3 years.

13. SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP – B. Tech (Computer Science & Engineering) –2
Two special seats will be offered based on merit list of JEE, and the Lovely Professional University will waive 100% fee.
Eligibility: 60% in Class XII Science PCM & JEE Result.

Note:

- Those who wish to apply for Sikyong Professional Scholarship program (SPSP) and Dalai Lama Trust (DLT) must apply for any of the courses mentioned in the DoE scholarship. The DoE will later publish separate announcement for SPSP & DLT scholarship.
- Those students who did not graduate from Tibetan schools shall be informed of the test center for Class X equivalent Tibetan test after the deadline of online application.
